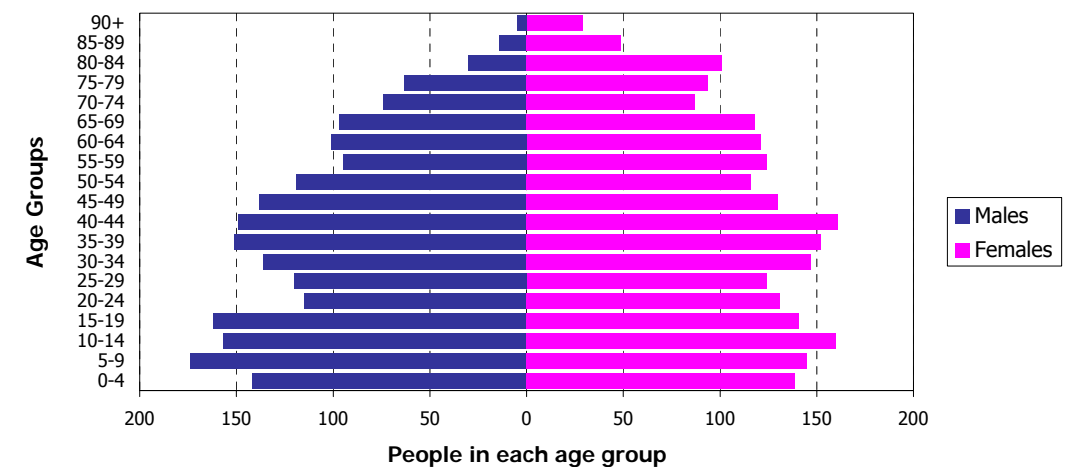

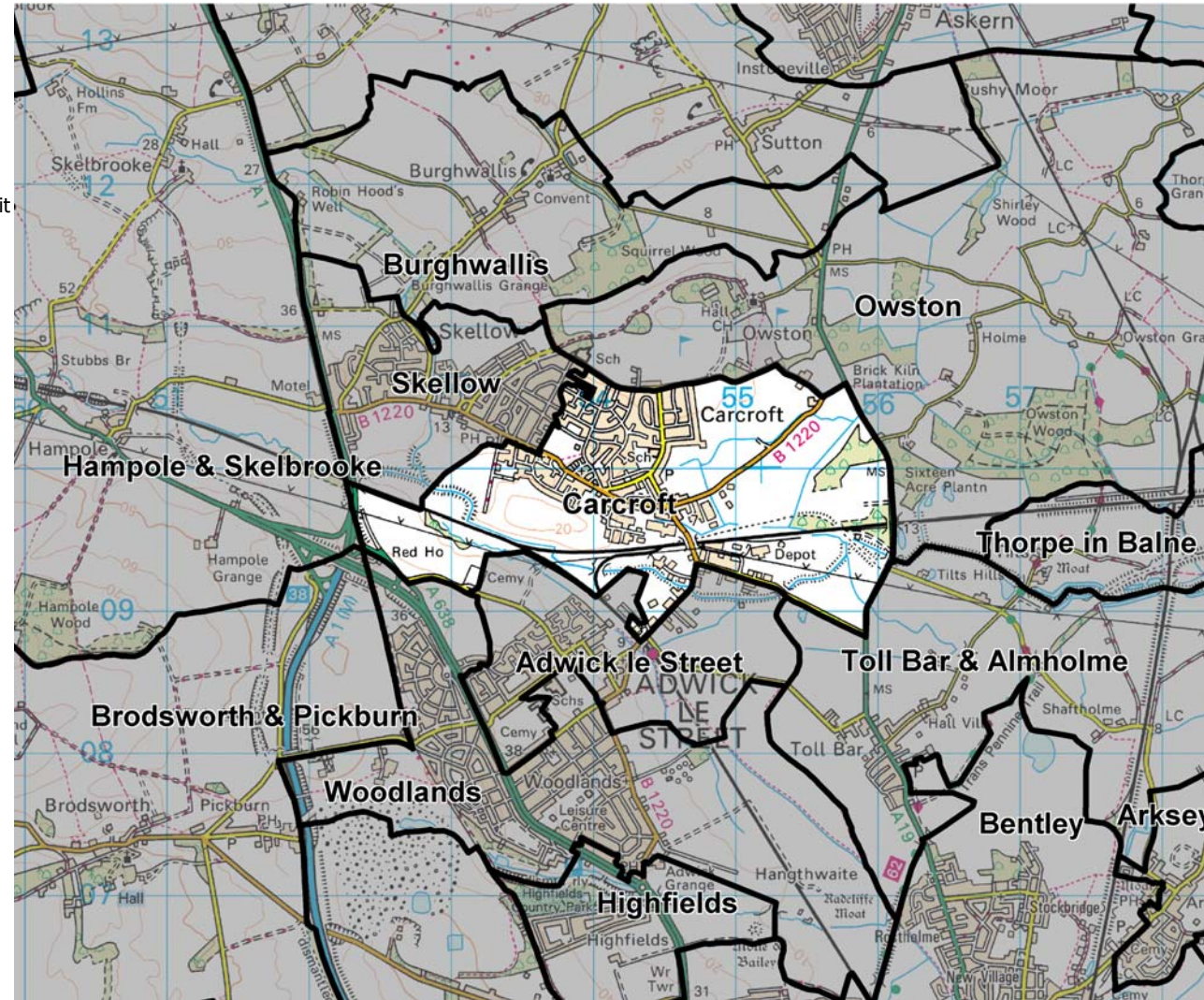

Births and Child Health

There were 165 births in Carcroft between 2001 and 2003. The general period fertility rate is 63.6 live births per 1,000 women aged 15–44, not significantly above the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Carcroft:

- 743 adults (22.3% of the 16+ population) and 59 children (6.8%) are obese
- 298 adults (8.9% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 66 males (3.2% of the population) and 122 females (5.4%) have diabetes
