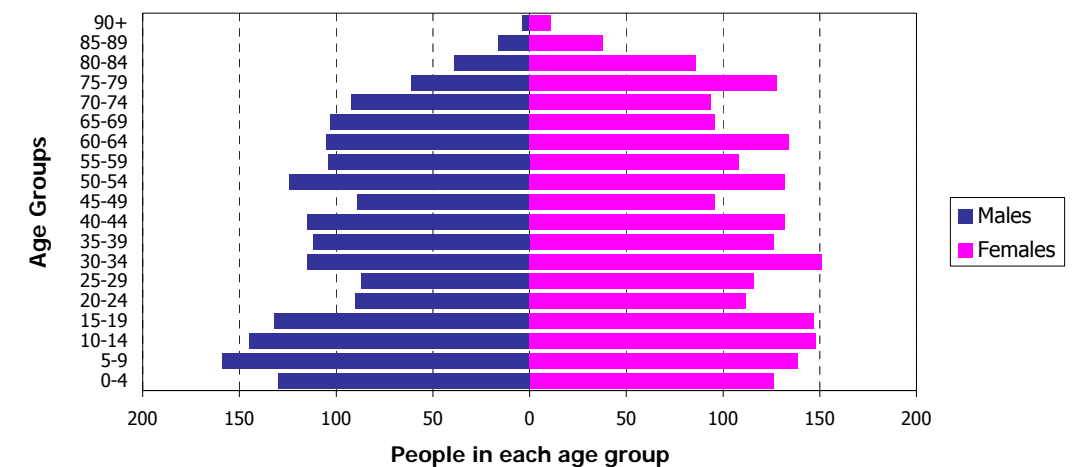

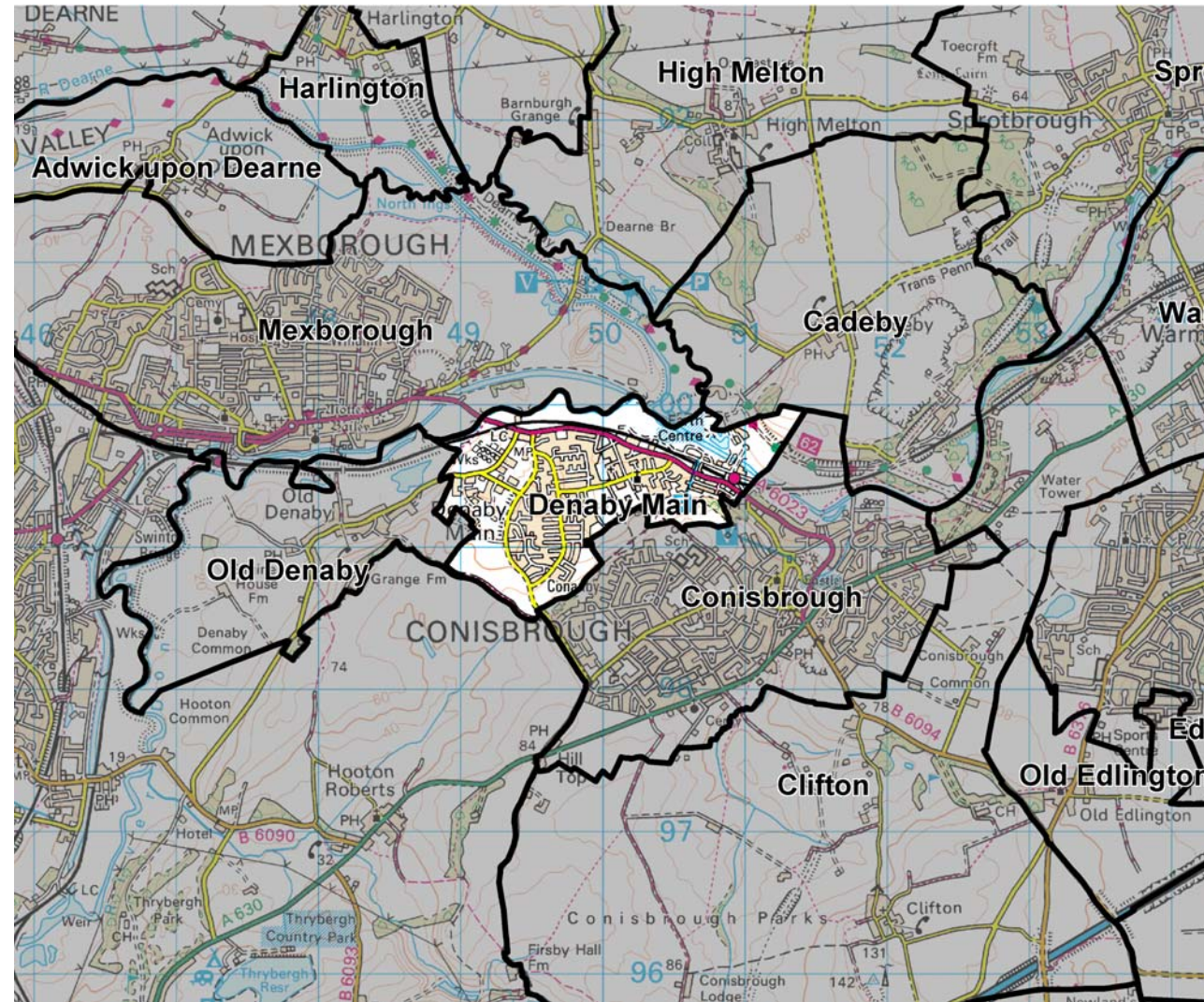

Births and Child Health

There were 176 births in Denaby Main between 2001 and 2003.

The general period fertility rate is 74.6 live births per 1,000 women aged 15–44, very significantly above the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Denaby Main:

- 679 adults (22.6% of the 16+ population) and 54 children (6.8%) are obese
- 316 adults (10.5% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 67 males (3.7% of the population) and 118 females (5.6%) have diabetes
