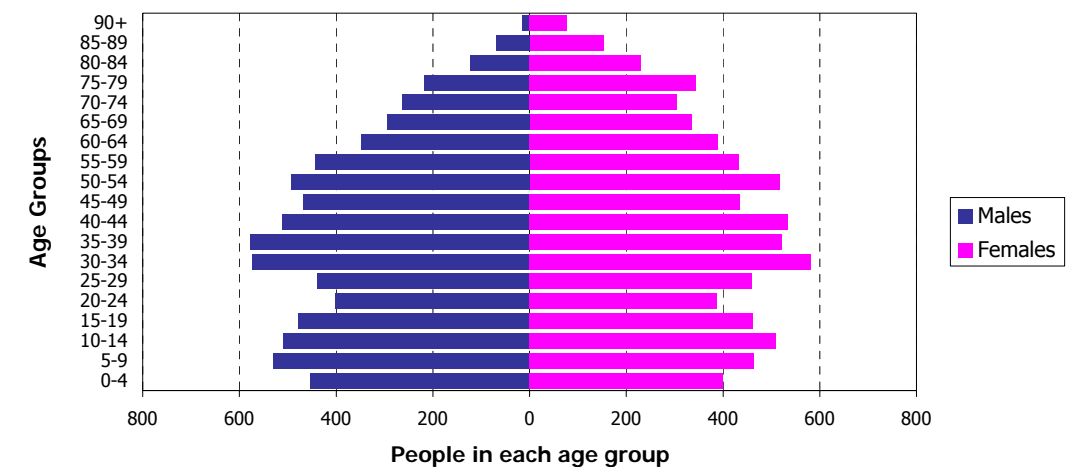

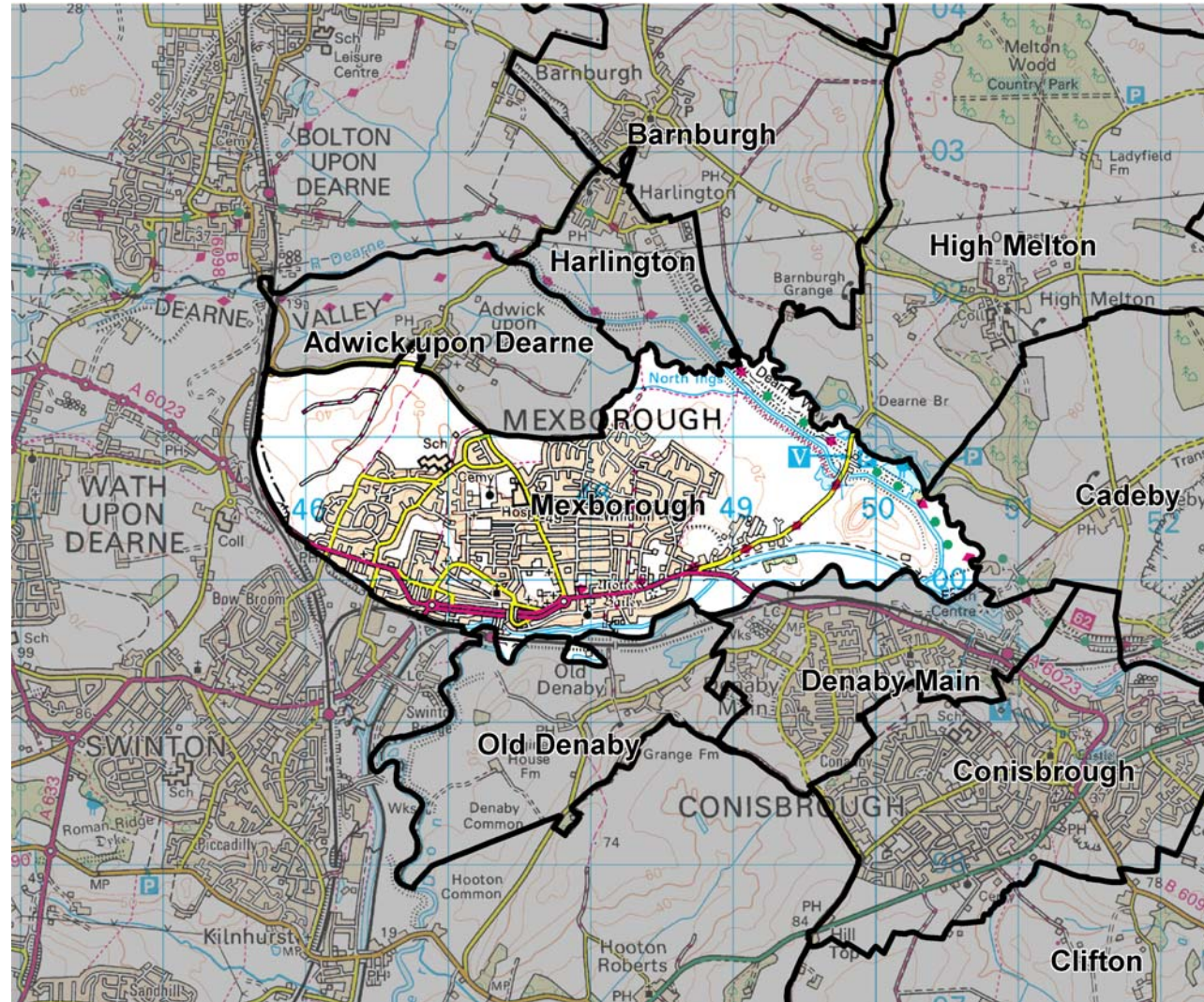

There were 475 births in Mexborough between 2001 and 2003.

The general period fertility rate is 53.6 live births per 1,000 women aged 15–44, not significantly below the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

## Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Mexborough:

- 2,615 adults (22.5% of the 16+ population) and 188 children (6.8%) are obese
- 925 adults (7.9% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 240 males (3.3% of the population) and 392 females (5.2%) have diabetes
