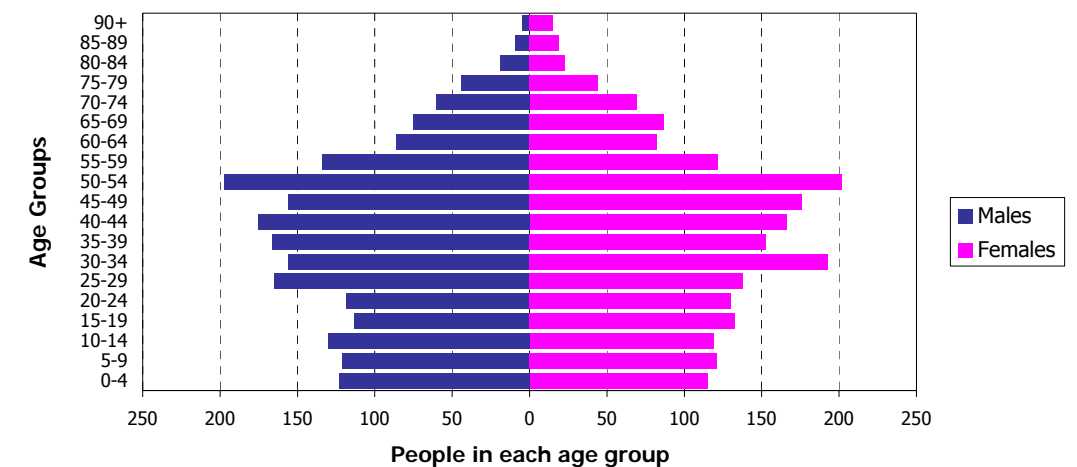

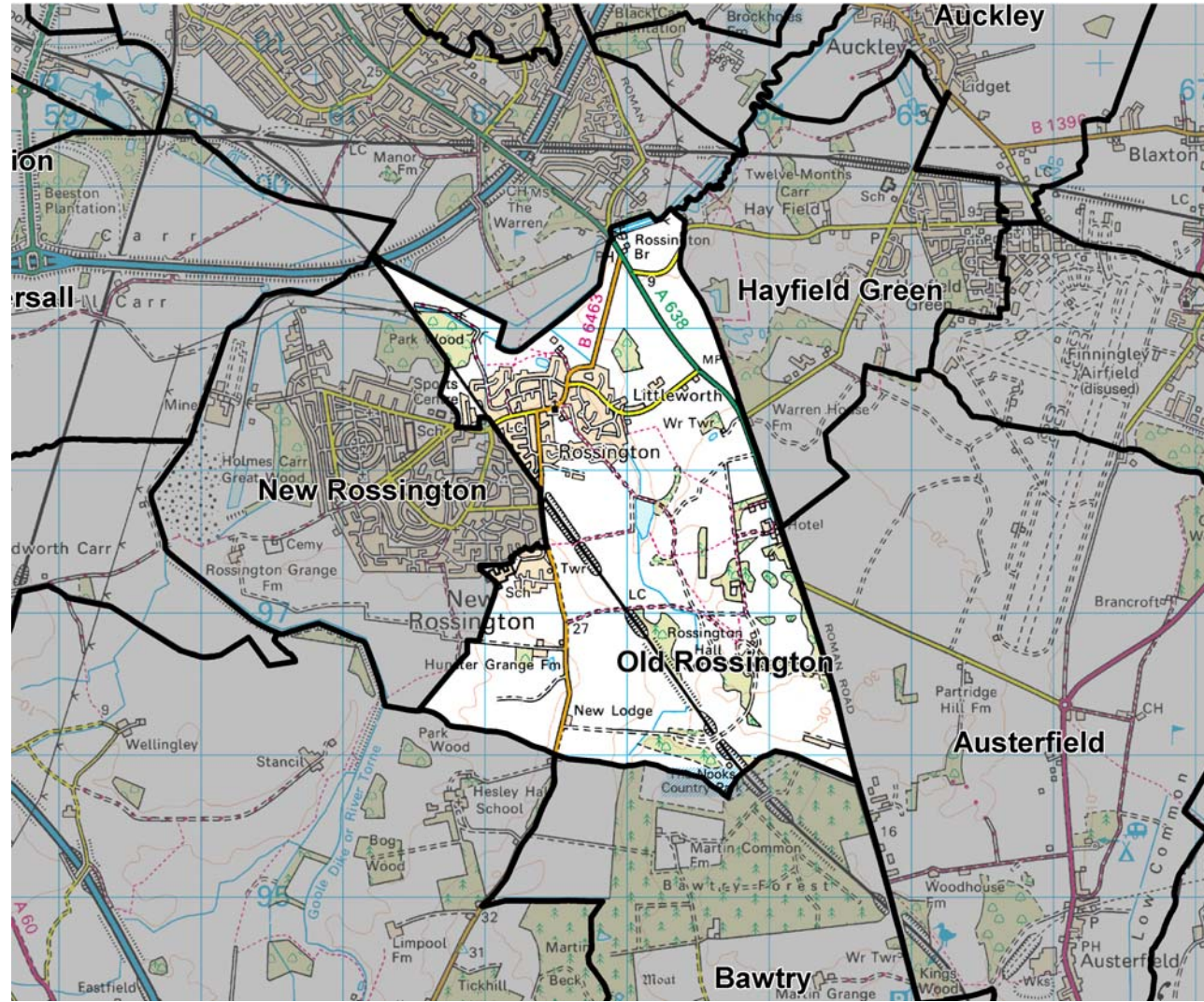

Births and Child Health

There were 171 births in Old Rossington between 2001 and 2003.

The general period fertility rate is 61.8 live births per 1,000 women aged 15-44, not significantly above the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Old Rossington:

- 762 adults (22.3% of the 16+ population) and 44 children (6.7%) are obese
- 149 adults (4.4% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 65 males (3.2% of the population) and 86 females (4.1%) have diabetes
