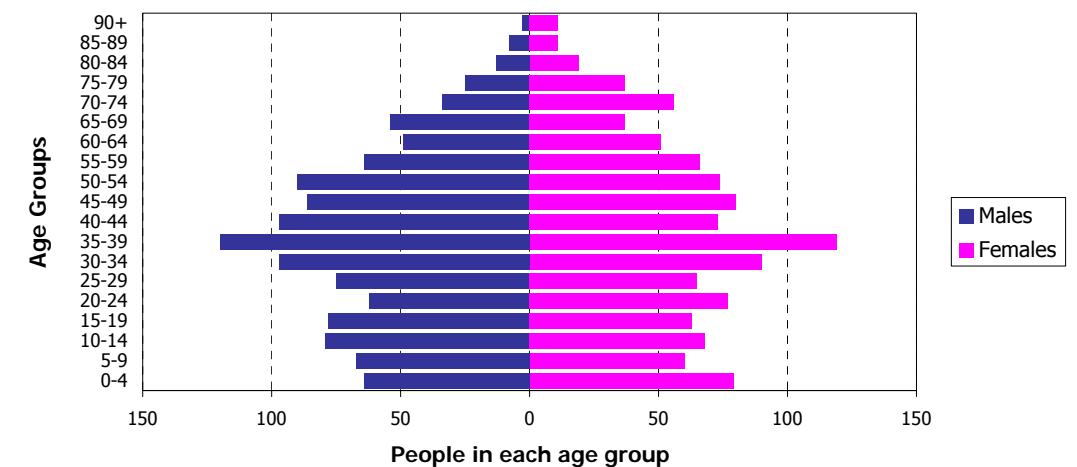

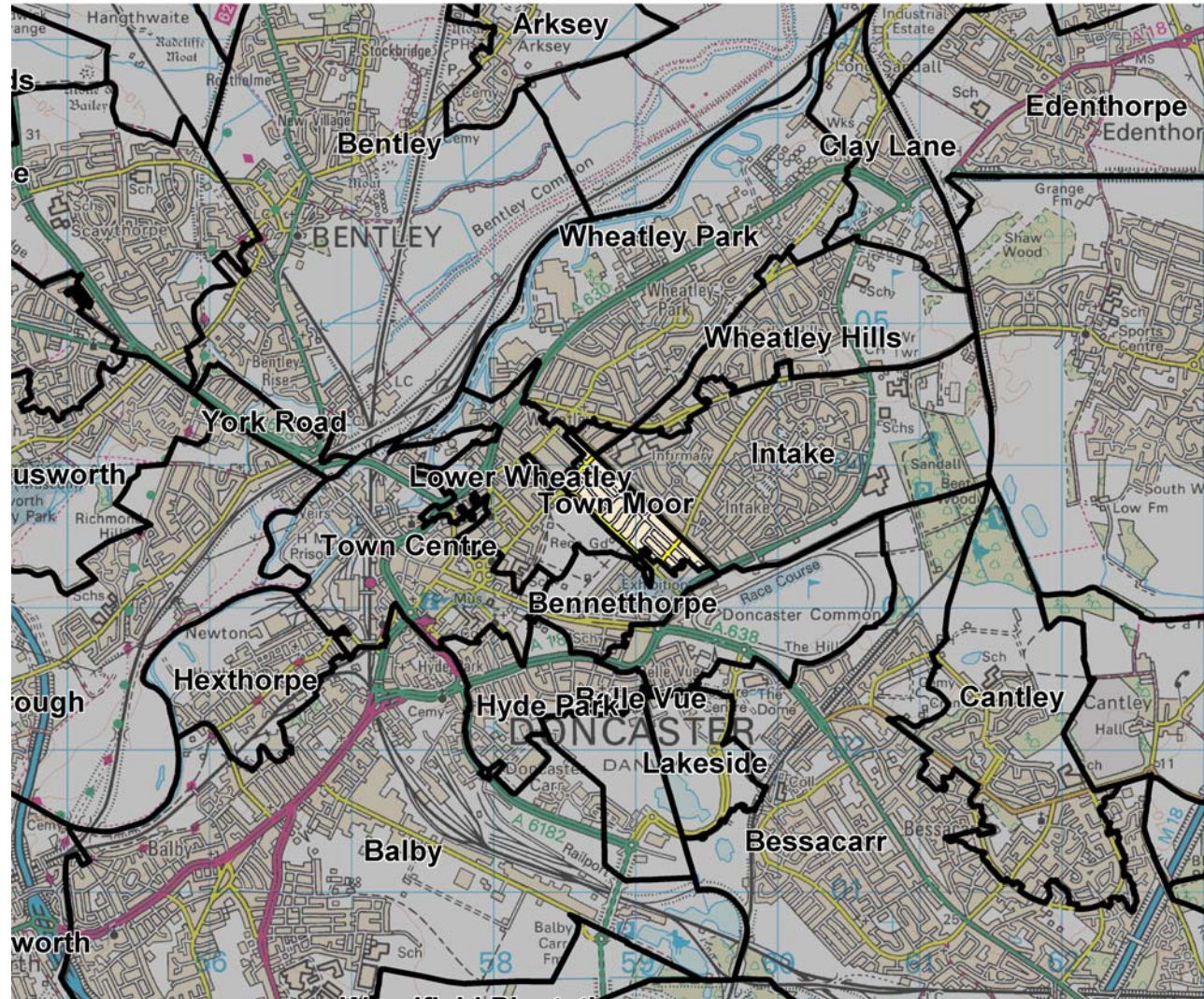

There were 75 births in Town Moor between 2001 and 2003. The general period fertility rate is 52.5 live births per 1,000 women aged 15–44, not significantly below the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Town Moor:

- 416 adults (22.5% of the 16+ population) and 27 children (6.8%) are obese
- 119 adults (6.4% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 40 males (3.4% of the population) and 52 females (4.6%) have diabetes
