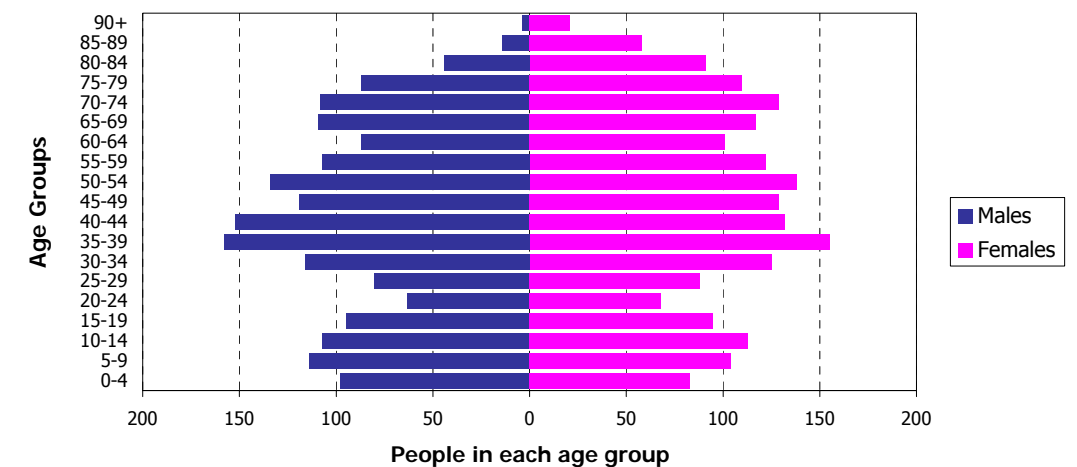

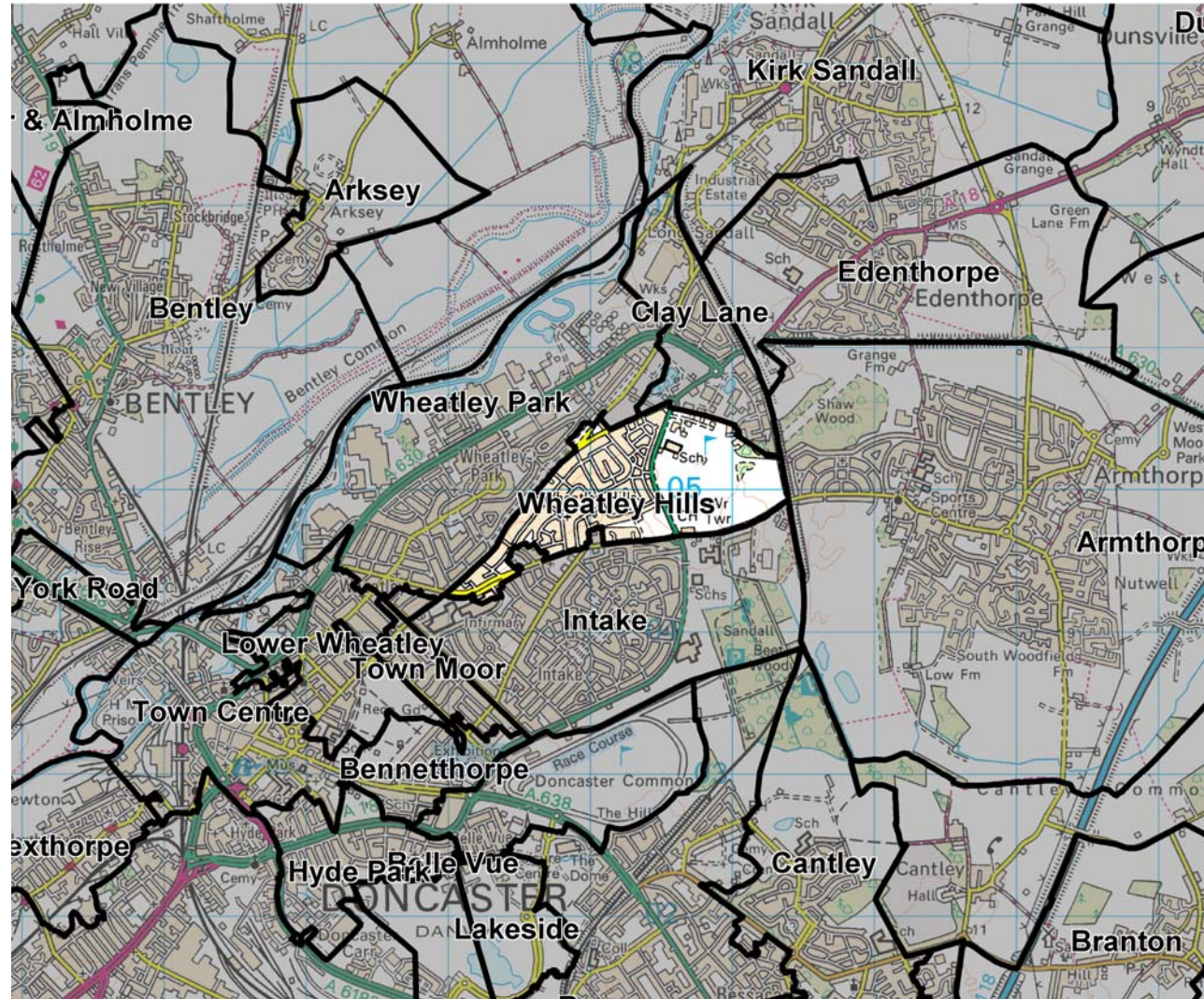

There were 107 births in Wheatley Hills between 2001 and 2003. The general period fertility rate is 54.7 live births per 1,000 women aged 15–44, not significantly below the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

## Modelled Prevalence Data

- 726 adults (23.2% of the 16+ population) and 42 children (6.8%) are obese
- 258 adults (8.3% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 75 males (4.2% of the population) and 129 females (6.5%) have diabetes
