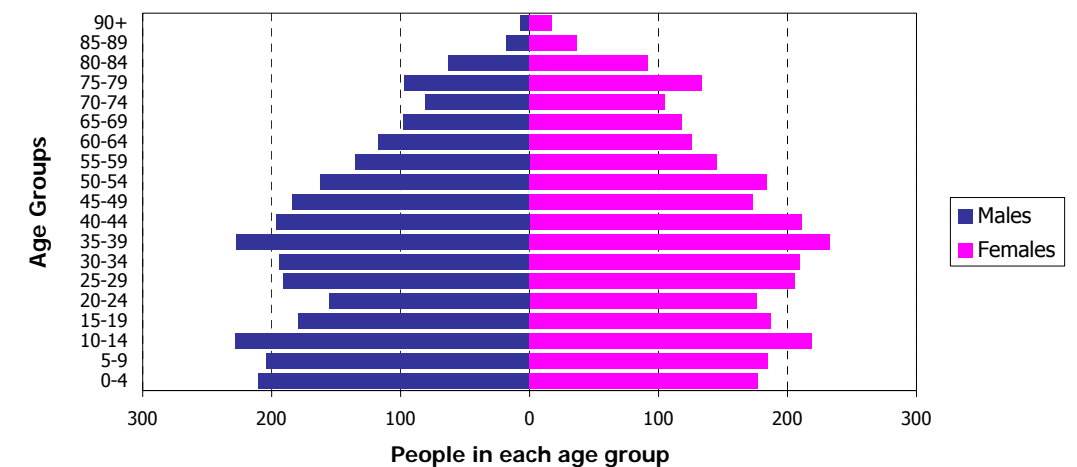

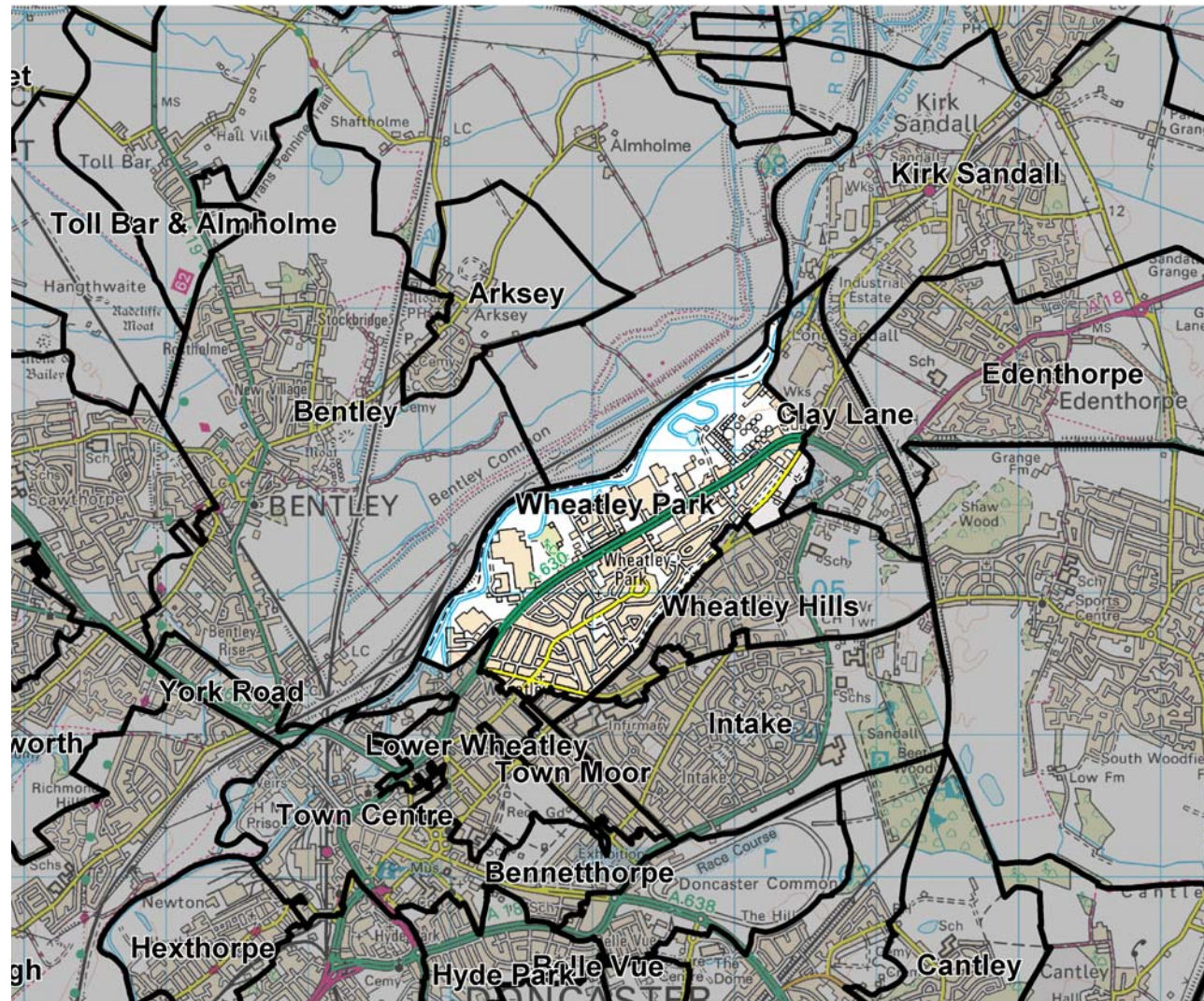

## Births and Child Health

There were 268 births in Wheatley Park between 2001 and 2003.

The general period fertility rate is 73.0 live births per 1,000 women aged 15-44, very significantly above the Doncaster average of 56.4 per 1,000.

## Modelled Prevalence Data

Using national survey data, we can predict that, in Wheatley Park:

- 968 adults (22.2% of the 16+ population) and 81 children (6.8%) are obese
- 326 adults (7.4% of the 16+ population) have coronary heart disease
- 88 males (3.2% of the population) and 141 females (4.8%) have diabetes
